Coon Valley Telephone will award a minimum of two \$500 Scholarships to rural high school seniors.

How it works

- **Applicants Must...**
 - Be a graduating high school senior
 - Be a dependent child of a Coon Valley Telephone member
 - Be accepted by an accredited two- or four-year college or university, or vocational-technical school. **Online classes do not qualify.**
 - Have at least a “C” accumulative grade point average. ***Please note this is not a scholarship based on a 4.0 average, but awarded to deserving students whose academic credentials fall within an average to above -average range.***
 - Express an interest to work in a rural community following graduation.
- **How to Apply**
 - Applications can be obtained by...
 - Picking up at Coon Valley Telephone Business Office in Menlo (516 Sherman St Menlo, IA 50164).
 - Picking up at the Farmers & Merchants Bank in Orient (114 S Broad St, Orient, IA 50858)
 - Applications are available at our website <http://www.coonvalleytelco.com/>
 - Complete the scholarship application in full.
 - Return Application to Coon Valley Telephone Business Office by April 10th, 2020 @ 12:00 noon. No late applications will be accepted.
- **Award Procedure**
 - Winner will be selected by an independent qualified committee.
 - Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis and will not be renewable
 - Award will be paid upon proof of registration at an institute of higher education, and will be payable after the completion of the first semester.
 - Scholarship will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, sex, or disability.
 - Incomplete application will not be considered.
